

## SCRIBE REPORT RUN 1938

Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2023 Hares: Campari, La Lasagna Nai Harn – Soi Naya

This week's Laager was at Soy Naya just north of Nai Harn lake. Basically it's a shit Laager site, too narrow, parking is very difficult and the circle area isn't a circle – more like an extended ellipse. Also you have to put up with though traffic and Hashers making a nuisance of themselves when they leave early. Other than that it's quite wonderful and provides a gateway to some really good Hashing territory.



Hares were called in who explained that we would be running on '**Classic**' multicolour and the walkers would be on '**standard**' blue after an initial 1km or so on the multicolour. Mannekin Pis was named as Horn and was requested to look after it well as it had just got back from the 'menders'. Newcomers were also told that if they see pink they can be sure they are following the 'true' trail – more about that later.



I opted to go on the run after my abject failure to complete anything last week. I was also very interested to see if Campari's claim that the run would comprise 70% of virgin trails. Here you will see my recording of the trail that I followed which totalled about 4.5km and a total ascent of 255 metres. This includes about 300m between the green and red markers as I forgot to turn my watch on. It was in this section I saw my first faller **Kill Her** who I think turned back at this point. I think I put him off with my penetrating questions about whether he was walking or running. Next casualty we saw was **Jiggly Jugs** who was on her way back after crocking her ankle. Shame she decided to do it at the point furthest from

the Laager site. At this juncture I was in back marker mode with **Philthy Pisshead** and a few others where we seemed to be checking all the falsies due to misleading laying of pink paper- one comes to expect more of an ex Run Master cum Horn. We got to a point on top of the hill where the trail went off to the right but we could see other others down below us going in the opposite direction. I thought this would be a good time to do a tactical shortcut and left **PP** and **Co** to their own devices. I did find the trail below me which I started to

follow but did not see the people who should have been ahead of me. At this point the amount of paper being laid had increased so much and coupled with pink paper laid in a lasse fait manner it was becoming very difficult to see whether we were on the true trail or not. I was also beginning to see more and more runners due to all the apparent confusion and yet we still ended up checking out some massive falsies (see the map for confirmation). There were a couple more fallers, me included, but eventually we made it back in reasonable time before the circle commenced. Feedback from my boss Chief Scribe **Takes It All In** was that the walk was a 30 minute doddle but she did say she was 'power walking'. Other than all the above it was quite a good run but the virgin trail bit I must have misheard – more like 17%.

**Tootsie** led the run offences and brought in **Campari, La Lasagna**, **Who The Fuck is Alice, Manekin Pis,** and **Fungus** to make the point how similar the trails were to previous Saturday Hashes, Tinmen etc and that whilst the first half was good **Campari** seemed to have lost the plot in the second half with so many falsies exacerbated by poor pink paper laying by **MP**.
